4. Name of the personal data file and data subjects

Data file of members of the Finnish Mass Spectrometry Society.

Data subjects include the private persons who have applied for and have been accepted as members of the Finnish Mass Spectrometry Society.

5. Purposes of personal data processing and legal basis for processing

The controller processes data included in the data file for the purpose of maintaining a register of members of the Finnish Mass Spectrometry Society. The legal basis for processing is consent given by the applicant and the requirements of the Finnish legislation (Yhdistyslaki 1989/503).

6. Categories of personal data

The following categories of personal data are processed in the data file: first name, last name, place of residence, e-mail address, title, affiliation, position, phone number, postal address, and membership of the mailing list of the Finnish Mass Spectrometry Society.

7. Recipients of personal data

Personal data will not be communicated to third parties without additional consent. Personal data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area.

8. Personal data retention period

The controller will retain the personal information as long as the person remains a member of the Finnish Mass Spectrometry Society.

9. Personal data sources and updates

Personal data is collected in the application form of the Finnish Mass Spectrometry Society.

10. Data subject's rights

You may at any given time and free of charge request a copy of your personal data in the data file. You may at any given time request the controller to rectify or erase your personal data from the data file, except for the first name, last name, and place of residence, which are required by the Finnish legislation (Yhdistyslaki 1989/503 § 11) to be included in the register of members of all associations registered in Finland.

Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority: you have the right to subject the legality of data processing activities to a review by the Data Protection Ombudsman, email: tietosuoja@om.fi.

11. Right to cancel prior consent

Consent given at application can be cancelled by canceling the membership in the Finnish Mass Spectrometry Society.
